

Moanalua Complex Orchestra Festival

**Note that the time has been revised since the last message. The block of time listed includes set up, tuning, warm-up, and performance for the group. Students should be available the entire time.*

930 am: Students report to U101 (Moanalua High School Band Room); unpack instrument; warm up

1030 am: Performance on the Performing Arts Center stage

1045 am: End; pack instrument in case; take instrument

Student and parents/guardians are responsible for arranging a meeting place after the student's performance is done. They are also responsible for taking home their instrument, music, and any other things that are brought to the festival.

Orchestra Performance Uniform:

- Solid white, long-sleeved, button up, collared shirt with which you can wear a necktie
- Shirt should be tucked in to the pants
- Solid black, long, dress pants
- Black dress shoes with black socks or stockings
- Necktie (purchased through the MMS Orchestra Booster Club)
- Solid black face mask
- Long hair tied back or pinned up

Students should arrive to the festival already dressed. There will be no time to change at the festival.

Things To Bring:

- Instrument
- Music in black binder in sheet protectors
- Tuner
- Endpin stopper (donut) for cellos and basses

Audience Information:

- Seating capacity is 75% hall maximum (520 seats)
- Everyone **MUST** take a seat. If the seating area fills, ticket sales will stop until seats are again available.
- Admission fee is \$3; general seating (children under 3 free of charge); tickets will be sold at the Moanalua High School Performing Arts Center box office on the day of the festival.
- Face masks are mandatory for audience members for Hawaii Department of Education indoor events.
- Audience may listen to all ensembles.
- If leaving the auditorium, audience must get stamped for re-entry.
- Students will be allowed to watch any performance as long as it does not conflict with the times listed above.
- Students do not have to pay, as long as they are in their **FULL ORCHESTRA PERFORMANCE UNIFORM**. If the hall fills, student performers may be asked to vacate the hall to allow paying guests to take a seat.
- No food or drinks are allowed in the hall. Water is ok if it is enclosed and sealed in a proper container (cups with straws are not considered sealed).
- NO VIDEO OR RECORDING DEVICES ALLOWED**. Use of electronics is **STRICTLY** prohibited in the hall. This includes phones, tablets, game units. The performance is being recorded and will be available on YouTube.
