### **DROP OFF AND PICK UP**

Drop off students at the Performing Arts Center, which is at the parking entrance on Ala Ilima Street. When arriving at Moanalua High School, students should go directly to the Music Room, which is the building next to the Performing Arts Center. They should unpack their instruments, tune, and warm-up. They should be respectful of the space and listen to directions from the parent chaperones.

Students must remain at the high school through the end of the concert, which will most likely be around 5:15 pm.

## **SNACKS AND WATER BOTTLE**

All students should eat lunch before arriving. Snacks will be provided by the MMS Orchestra Boosters to the student orchestra officers, Giocosos Strings, and String Orchestra due to their earlier arrival times. All students may bring snacks but should consume them outside, not in any of the rooms. A specific snack time will be given to student orchestra officers, Giocosos Strings and String Orchestra students, but not to Chamber Strings. There will be short breaks in the schedule that will allow Chamber Strings students to quickly consume their own snacks brought from home. Remember, snacks will only be provided to orchestra officers, Giocosos Strings, and String Orchestra, not to Chamber Strings. **All students should bring their own water bottles to stay hydrated.**

## **ORCHESTRA PERFORMANCE UNIFORM**

- Solid white, long-sleeved, button up, collared shirt with which you can wear a necktie
  - Depending on the style of the shirt, shirt should be tucked in to the pants
- Solid black, long, dress pants
- Black dress shoes with black socks or stockings
- Necktie\* - Purchased through the orchestra program
- Long hair tied back with black or white band
- Black face mask if choosing to wear a mask (these will not be provided)

*\*This is a special order necktie that is ordered through a mainland company and cannot be bought locally. The design is chosen by the 8th grade, and is worn by both 8th and 7th grades.*

## **None of the following:**

- T-shirts, straps, low necklines, or backless tops
- Jeans, jeggings, capris, pants with slits, leggings, skirts, or shorts
- Athletic shoes, boots, heels taller than 2", slippers, or sandals
- Excessive jewelry, accessories, or radical hairstyles
- Exposed stomachs or lower backs (waist must be covered when seated)

## **DONATION**

Most, if not all, of our concerts are free-of-charge, however, we will have a donation box if you would like to show financial support. Audience members will be welcomed into the auditorium at about 3:30 pm.

## **GUESTS**

While there is no limit to the amount of guests students may invite, please be mindful that we have about 170 students performing. We want all guests to be able to support the students. We do not have the resources at this time to manage a reservation-ticket system. We are confident that family and friends will arrange themselves in the auditorium in order to accommodate everyone. If we need to move orchestra students sitting in the auditorium in order to accommodate guests, we will do so.
